Powder coater and paint prep

GK Machine Inc - Donald, OR April 2022 to August 2022

Prep work area for upcoming work orders. All parts are sandblasted to remove all old paint and rust to reveal only metal surfaces. After proper blasting, parts are separated by size and type of paint. Then transported to paint department on pallets and checked by paint team. Parts are hung onto rolling carts per work order color and coordinate by weight and size. Carts are then arranged and grouped by color in front of powder booth for maximum production time management. Booth flooring is swept and walls are wiped before switching colors to prevent cross contamination. Carts are arranged in powder booth and blown down with compressed air for sand removal. All parts surfaces are wiped down with alcohol to prevent chemical contamination. Box of powder is picked by color from the supply room and arranged

onto powder gun machine. Powder gun is prepped and parts are blown down a 2nd time to ensure surface purity. Insert plugs into threaded holes or apply tape per customer instructions on blueprints. After powder coating, Carts are then rolled manually into proper oven for parts bake. Time permitted for baking parts is determined by type and thickness of metal, and in some cases what color of powder being used. While current parts are baking, box of power is weighed to report the amount of powdered used per work order. Box is returned to storage room and booth is prepped for the next color. Process is repeated until work is finished and time to clock out. Any Down-time is used for clean up and maintenance.

Aircraft Canopy Fabricator and finisher

Van's Aircraft - Aurora, OR September 2021 to April 2022

The original manual for fabricating these aircraft canopies was severely outdated. During canopy fabrication I documented my progress and created an updated version for future production.

By using metal parts, fiberglass materials, and micro balloon filler, each canopy is custom molded and temporarily installed for proper fitment to each aircraft frame. After fiberglass molding is cured, canopy is removed from airframe and sanded down for filler. After laying mud filler, sand down and prep for primer. Transfer canopy to paint booth and prep for primer. Prep primer and gun. After shooting, primer gun is cleaned and canopy sits for cure time. Primer is then sanded and prepped for final paint. Once aircraft is fully assembled and painted, the painted canopy is permanently installed.
